SMART METERS MEASURE CAMPUS ENERGY DATA

To date, 50 smart meters across 22 buildings are online and functional with many more to come.

Energy & Engineering, in partnership with the electrical shop, has been working diligently to install the smart-metering technology throughout the campus. **Alejandro Gonzalez**, associate energy engineer, has been leading the effort.

The meters support energy management measures, detailed power quality analysis, and billing recharge for FS. They can also monitor the electrical infrastructure at critical points in real time, and determine the root cause of power disruptions in minutes.
