Plumbing in-house repair saves \$40 K

Jeff Wyrick, Rich Cordova, Omar Medel, and Steve Crook from the plumbing shop have been assiduously working on a large, underground leak that supplies the fire suppression water to the School of Medicine Research building.

It involved cutting out two, sizable risers that were compromised

by heat from the nearby tunnel. The trench was over 10' deep and required trench shoring to safely work.

The plumbing shop was able to excavate and place the shoring, followed by replacing the c-900 plastic riser with ductile iron pipe, all in house instead of contracting out.
